## Jonah 1:1-3

<sup>1</sup>Now the word of Yahweh came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, <sup>2</sup>"Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and preach against it, for their wickedness has come up before me." <sup>3</sup>But Jonah rose up to flee to Tarshish from the presence of Yahweh. ## Jonah 4:6-10

<sup>6</sup>Yahweh God prepared a vine, and made it to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shade over his head, to deliver him from his discomfort. So Jonah was exceedingly glad because of the vine.

<sup>7</sup>But God prepared a worm at dawn the next day, and it chewed on the vine, so that it withered. <sup>8</sup>It happened, when the sun arose, that God prepared a sultry east wind; and the sun beat on Jonah's head, so that he fainted, and requested for himself that he might die, and said, "It is better for me to die than to live."

<sup>9</sup>God said to Jonah, "Is it right for you to be angry about the vine?" He said, "I am right to be angry, even to death." <sup>10</sup>Yahweh said, "You have been concerned for the vine, for which you have not labored, neither made it grow; which came up in a night, and perished in a night.

## Jonah 3:5
